A REPORT ON THE ACTIVE CITIZENSHIP PROGRAMME HELD IN THE COLLEGE
HALL ON 20.11.2014

“Active Citizenship Programme” was launched by the State Government on 2nd October 2014 with a focus on promoting life skill, leadership and active citizenship among youth. The programme aims to install moral values and practical traits based on patriotism, civic sense, gender sensitization, drug abuse, and empathy for the differently-abled among others within the youth to compete and excel in today’s competitive environment and contribute towards the overall goal of nation building.

Odisha is among the first state in the country to have undertaken such an innovative and appealing programme for the youth in the Odisha State Youth Policy 2013 and National Youth Policy 2014.

In order to encourage such programme through educational institution and among the youth, the Active Citizenship Programmes were organized in the college by the Departments of Sports & Youth Services, Government of Odisha in collaboration with the college NSS units in order to create an awareness and motivational attitude among the college students as a means of life skill education, leadership quality and making them a responsible citizen.

Feeling the necessity of the above concept and in order to educate the student mass on the topic, an active citizenship programme was undertaken by the NSS unit of the college on 20.11.14 at 11.00 a.m in the college Hall. The programme was held for a duration of 3 Hrs. as an interactive workshop on the theme “Active Citizenship” in which a total number 206 participants including 196 students both boys and girls and 10 numbers of members of staff have joined. Mr. P.K.Mishra, an eminent Resource Person from the department of Sports & Youth Services, Government of Odisha addressed the seminar and gave an inspirational and motivational speech to the students and reminded about their role in active citizenships.

The workshop was followed by screening of an audio-visual documentary film show on “active citizenship” as a means to make the students more realistic in their vision and acceptance. At the end of the session, the students were found to be more positive in their views and were greatly motivated by the programme and suggested for more number of such programmes to be held in their college in future.

A Seminar under active citizenship programme for educational institution was organized in the College Assembly Hall on **13. 02. 2015** at **10.30 a.m** in collaboration with the department of Sports & Youth Services, Government of Odisha through their representative as resource person to address the seminar and sensitize our students in various ethics of human life and motivating them in order to make them a better citizen.

The Programme was based on the theme “**Gender Sensitization**” and was of 2 Hrs. duration in which around 204 participants including students and members of staff of the college attended. The seminar was presided over by the Principal. Among others were some of the senior Faculties and Programme officer, NSS boys unit.
